



MESSAGE 5:

TO HIM BE GLORY FOREVER

PASSAGE: ROMANS 11:36 ESV

36 For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.

MESSAGE GOAL:

The goal of this message is to emphasize the sovereignty, creativity, sustenance, and ultimate purpose of God in all things. It aims to exalt God as the source of all creation, the sustainer of life, and the ultimate goal of existence. Through numerous biblical references and declarations, the message seeks to inspire reverence, gratitude, devotion, and ultimately worship, towards God, urging listeners to recognize and honor His supreme authority and worthiness of praise. light and mark the seasons.
God created seed-bearing plants and seed-
bearing fruits to provide food for animals
and humans.
God created animals to fill the earth and
contribute to its diversity.
God created humans to fill the earth and
steward over the earth.

God sustains water by setting it within
boundaries and maintaining their boundaries

as it goes through various cycles, psalm
104:6-9.

God sustains the sky by maintaining its
structure, and regulating weather and
climate, Psalm 135:7.

God sustains the land by visiting it and
watering it, Psalm 65:9.

God sustains the sun, moon and stars, by
holding them and ensuring that not one is
missing, Isaiah 40:26.

God sustains seed-bearing fruits and seed-
bearing plants by giving it soil, water,
sunlight, and seasons, Isaiah 55:10-11.

God sustains the soil by enriching it with
rain and water, Psalm 65:9-10.

God sustains animals by providing them the
food they need, Matthew 6:26.

God sustains human beings by providing all
of our basic needs, Acts 17:28.

God sustains human beings by giving human
beings His Spirit in Christ Jesus, John 6:63.

idols, Isaiah 42:8.

Let your light so shine before others, that
they may see your good deeds and glorify
your father in heaven, Matthew 5:16
To him be glory forever!

This is to my Father's glory, that you bear
much fruit, showing yourselves to be my
disciples, John 15:8.
To him be glory forever!

In view of God's mercy, Present your bodies
as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to
God, this is your true and proper worship,
romans 12:1.

of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you
